DNA REQUIREMENTS FOR NATIONAL EVENTS

DNA: All dogs entered in the ABC National Specialty Show (with the exception of dogs registered with an ILP/PAL number and dogs under the age of 2 years at the start of the event) must have a DNA profile, either permanent or temporary, on record with the AKC. The DNA number must be included on all entry forms. The entry form (including online) will provide a space for you to enter your dog's DNA number. For the National Specialty Show, dogs entered only in the Parade of Champions class (Exhibition Only) do not need to have a DNA number on file. DNA Kits may be ordered through the AKC website. Please allow 8-12 weeks for processing.

Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11, section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>. Most important are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor Class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period for 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf>.
3. If you have question or need assistance with registration or obtaining an extension, please contact the AKC Special Services Department at: awards@akc.org or (919) 233-9767 (followed by selecting option 4)

From the North: I-540W/US-71S via EXIT 7 toward Van Buren/Fort Smith (0.9 mile) Merge onto US-64W/US-71 BRS via EXIT 2A toward Van Buren (2.0 Miles) Turn slight LEFT onto Broadway St/US-64/US-71 BR. Continue to follow US-64/US-71 BR. (2.3 miles) 4400 Midland Blvd. Enter at the second gate of the fairgrounds.

From the East: I40-W via the ramp on the LEFT toward Fort Smith. Merge onto I-540-W/ US-71S via Exit 7 toward Van Buren/Fort Smith (0.9 mile) Merge onto US-64/US-71 BR S via EXIT 2A toward Van Buren (2.0 Miles) Turn slight LEFT onto Broadway St. US-64/US-71 BR. Continue to follow US-64/US-71 BR (2.3 Miles) 4400 Midland Blvd. Enter at the second gate of the fairgrounds.

SHOW SITE

The Show Grounds at this Show constitute the entire fairgrounds. The show site will be available to exhibitors after 5:00 pm on Tuesday November 17, 2026 . No dogs may be left in the building overnight. All equipment, crates must be removed from the building by 7:00 PM Nov 21st, 2026. There will be no off loading during the obedience & rally competitions on Wednesday November 18th. All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee of this show giving club on these days will be strictly enforced, but not limited to that which is recorded in the premium list. Show Grounds Open Daily from 7 am - 10 pm.

Grooming and vending will be in the same area as the show.

This is a self cleaning show and all exhibitors will be required to keep their areas clean. In the free grooming area, crates must be stacked and there is NO electricity available. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates. Exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean will be asked to leave. Dogs may be exercised only in designated areas outside the show building. You are welcome to bring your own exercise pens, but they must be set up in designated places. Exercise pens are not to be left unattended. This will be strictly enforced. Dogs found in an un-safe environment, distress or harm's way (i.e. left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip:left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be moved to safety.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at all times, including in the ring. No gasoline or diesel generators allowed in the building. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at all times, including in the ring. Pooper scoopers and trash cans will be available. Not cleaning up after your dog will result in action (including a Bench Show Hearing) from the Show Committee. This includes complaints received from hotels. Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks and toilets is prohibited. NO DOGS will be allowed in restrooms. Dog bathing facilities will be available outside the building; please do not bath dogs in the restrooms.

Parking: 30 Minute loading and unloading zone will be clearly marked. All parking will be on a first come, first serve basis. Extra spaces may not be saved by roping off, using empty crates, exercise pens, chairs or any equipment. Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be moved or rearranged to accommodate vehicles. All vehicles will be parked at the owner's risk and the American Brittany Cub will NOT BE responsible for loss by fire, burglary, theft or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents. ABC recommends having an identifying collar on your dog when it is not being shown. If a dog should happen to get loose, please contact the Show Chairman or Committee Member immediately.

Dual Champion Class: For Dogs & Bitches that are Dual Champion of record as of the date of closing of the show.

Field Trial Class: For Dogs & Bitches that are Field Trial or Amateur Trial Champions or dogs that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial the current year beginning with the closing date of entries for the previous year's National Specialty Show through the closing date of the present year.

FOR DOGS THAT HAVE NOT EARNED their Field Trial or Amateur Trial Championship the date, name of trial & placement must be included with the entry form, see entry form, or the class will not be processed. If entering online an email should be sent to _____ with the dogs AKC # and information required above clearly listed.

NOTE: Dogs & Bitches Placing First in the Veteran Classes, Field Trial Classes & Dual Champion Classes Shall Be Eligible to Compete in the Best of Breed Competition provided they have not been defeated in any other class.

Awards of Merit: The judge, at their own discretion, may award up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry Awards of Merit.

Best Puppy in Regular Classes: For First Place winners in the following classes: Puppy Classes 6-9 month Dogs and Bitches, 9-12 month Dogs and Bitches, Bred-By-Exhibitor Dogs and Bitches. Best Puppy will be selected following the judging of Best of Breed Competition.

Best Bred-by-exhibitor in Regular Classes: For First Place winners in the Regular and Puppy Bred-By-Exhibitor Dog Class and Regular and Puppy Bred-By-Exhibitor Bitch Class. Best Bred-by-Exhibitor will be selected following the judging of Best of Breed Competition.

Best Veteran: For First Place winners in the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes. Best Veteran will be selected following the judging of Best of Breed Competition

For Dogs & Bitches that are Field Trial or Amateur Trial Champions or dogs that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial the current year beginning with the closing date of entries for the previous year's National Specialty Show through the closing date of the present year. The date, name of trial & placement must be included with the entry form IF NOT A Field Trial or Amateur Trial Champion, see entry form, or the class will not be processed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog (Get MUST BE entered in Another Class) — NATIONAL ONLY A castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class Maximum of Get to be shown with the Stud Dog

Brood Bitch (Produce MUST BE entered in Another Class) — NATIONAL ONLY A spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class. Maximum of 3 Produce to be shown with the Brood Bitch.

Brace (this fee is per brace) — NATIONAL ONLY Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Brace A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a celebration of the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handlers and is open to purebred dogs that are at least six months of age. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniels (Black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (Longhaired, Smooth, Wirehaired), Bull Terriers (Colored, White), Manchester Terriers (Standard, Toy), Chihuahuas (Smooth Coat, Long Coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (Toy, Miniature, Standard), Collies (Rough, Smooth).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is Limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
