A neutered male may enter the Veteran Dog Class & a spayed bitch may enter the Veteran Bitch Class.
1st placements in each class may compete for Best of Breed.

Herding Titled Classes: Dogs and bitches that have an AKC Herding Started title or above are eligible to compete in the herding titled class. Dogs and bitches which have achieved a conformation CH or GCH should enter the Herding Titled Champion Class. Dogs and bitches may NOT be altered.

Veteran Class: Dogs and bitches must be 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. AKC CH or GCH is not required to enter as long the animal is within age limits. Dogs and bitches MAY BE altered to compete in these classes.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be awarded following Best of Breed.

Awards of Merit

At the conclusion of the Best of Breed judging, the Judge may, at his/her discretion, award up to 10 (Saturday) or 7 (Sunday) Awards of Merit. The Judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. All dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition are eligible for this award.

Best Veteran

Best Veteran will be selected from the winners of the four Veterans Classes

Best Herding Titled

Best Herding Titled will be selected from the winners of the four Herding Titled Classes

Best Smooth

Best Smooth will be selected from the winners of the two Open Smooth Dog and Open Smooth Bitch classes as well as any smooth entries in the BOB class.

Best Bred By Exhibitor Competition

Remember to check the box on the entry form.

The dogs that win the four Bred By Exhibitor classes (puppy dogs, adult dogs, puppy bitches and adult bitches) along with any dogs or bitches entered for Best of Breed that are shown by their Breeder/Owner will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor. The winner of this award at the Saturday National Specialty and Sunday Parent Club Specialty will also receive one free AKC litter registration. *To be eligible for Best of Breed BBE, one must check the appropriate box on the entry form indicating their participation. All BOB eligible entries will be indicated by a hashtag (#) in the catalog.*

**National Owner Handled Series, Best Bred By Exhibitor, Best Herding Titled Dog,
Best Veteran, Best Smooth**

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES (Thursday Only)

Note: As a judge's decision in the Non-Regular Multiple Dog Entry Classes are based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows allows neutered dogs and spayed bitches to be shown in single entry non-regular classes and as the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch in classes offered at Independent Specialties.

Brace Class: For two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in Brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class only," full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If more than one Brace is entered by same dog owner, dogs comprising EACH Brace must be designated as "Brace 1", "Brace 2", etc.

Stud Dog Class: for Stud Dogs and at least two (2) but no more than four (4) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The Stud Dog cannot be shown as the Get for another Stud Dog. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of Get. Offspring only to be judged based on their merits. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Conformation Classes, Best of Breed Competition or a Non-Regular Conformation Class (other than the Stud Dog Class) at this show.

Brood Bitch Class: same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get in the description above.

NATIONAL & PARENT SPECIALTY RESERVE POINTS

At the National and Parent Specialties, the dogs designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners' sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners. You can find the 2026 Schedule of Points here:

Crufts Certificates

Recipients of Saturday's National Specialty awards of BOB, BOS, BBE, Awards of Merit and Selects are eligible for entry in Crufts as a US International qualifier. Certificates will be awarded to those winners; the certificate is valid for Crufts entry in either 2027 or 2028 and must be submitted along with each entry for Crufts.

SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS

Pee Wee

Judge Katherine Halton Berns*

Pee Wee is a fun and free Special Attraction for children aged 5 to 9, as a Pre-Junior Showmanship activity. The safety of all children, dogs and adults are the top priority. The ring will be managed by a licensed AKC Junior's Judge. The Judge will explain the process and give simple directions. There will be no showing of dog teeth/bites. Please note the following important information:

- Dogs must be at least 4 months of age
- Dogs must have a proper collar and lead.
- Border Collies with AKC, PAL, and ILP numbers are eligible.
- No bitches in season are allowed.
- Pee Wee and dogs must be accompanied in the ring by a parent or guardian or another appropriate responsible handler.
- At the Judge's discretion a second lead may be required to be put on the dog for additional adult control.

To enter, the child's parent or guardian must fill out a Pee Wee Entry and Release Form. Sign up at the show at the Club Table in the grooming room any time prior to noon central time on Saturday, October 3, 2026. All participating Pee Wees get a Rosette and prize.

Plush Puppy

Judge Katherine Halton Berns*

Plush Puppy is another fun and free Special Attraction for children up to the age of 5 years. The ring will be managed by a licensed AKC Junior's Judge. Exhibitors will show a stuffed animal (preferably a dog, but other stuffed animals will be allowed) on leash. The Judge will explain the process and give simple directions. The participant may be accompanied with a Parent or Guardian if that is desired.

To enter, the child's parent or guardian must fill out a Plush Puppy Entry and Release Form. Sign up at the show at the Club Table in the grooming room any time prior to noon central time on Saturday, October 3, 2026. All participants get a Rosette and prize.

Additional Classes

Judge Honey Anne Glendinning

Five Special Attraction classes will be scheduled Thursday morning. These classes will continue until all five are completed. The amount of time this will take as well as the addition of a lunch break will depend on the number of entries and will be at the judge's discretion.

- Altered
- Smooth Coat
- Gait
- Front
- Head Piece

All Special Attraction classes will be divided by sex and First through Fourth non-regular placement ribbons will be awarded. Best Male and Best Female for each Special Attraction will directly compete against each other for Best Overall. A small trophy will be provided to the overall winner. Entries into these competitions are available in The BCSA Store.

**Provisional/Permit Status at the time of publication*

4 – 6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

Male and female puppies four months and under six months will compete together, with Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex only being awarded. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Puppies are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person or dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy to show dentition for the judge to avoid transmission of illness.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

Entries will be accepted by the Show Secretary on the entry form included in this premium list. Pre-entries ONLY.

Awards: Rosettes for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex

2026 FUTURITY/MATURITY

Futurity / Maturity is an annual event sponsored by the Border Collie Society of America, Inc. and is exclusively for the competition of puppies and juniors between four (4) months and under three (3) years of age. Only pups that have completed the two-part nomination process may compete at The National Specialty competition. Prizes are as described in the Futurity Rules and Regulations.

Futurity Classes will take place following the Non-Regular Multi-Dog National Specialty Classes on Thursday, October 1st, 2026, for the following classes:

Dogs, 4 mos. & under 6 mos.	Bitches, 4 mos. & under 6 mos.
Dogs, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.	Bitches, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.
Dogs, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.	Bitches, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.
Dogs, 12 mos. & under 18 mos.	Bitches, 12 mos. & under 18 mos.

First place from each class will compete for Best In Futurity and Runner Up Best in Futurity.

Maturity classes will take place at the conclusion of the Futurity Competition

Dogs, 18 mos & under 2 yrs.	Bitches, 18 mos & under 2 yrs.
Dogs, 2 yrs & under 3 yrs.	Bitches, 2 yrs & under 3 yrs

First place from each class will compete for Best in Maturity and Runner Up Best in Maturity.

FOR ALL SWEEPSTAKES

The club will retain 35% to cover expenses. Sweepstakes payouts will be rounded to the nearest dollar. Any unawarded money will be retained by the club. There are no handler restrictions in Sweepstakes competition(s).

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Sweepstakes is open to all Border Collie dogs and bitches 6 months of age and under 24 months of age. Each entry must also be entered in the Regular Class at the National Specialty. Champions of Record are eligible to compete. At the completion of the individual class judging, each of the class winners shall be brought back into the ring for award of Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes. Indicate your entry in SWEEPSTAKES including age division in the box marked "Additional Classes. "

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Veteran Sweepstakes open to Border Collie dogs and bitches who on the day of the show will be at least 7 years of age. Entries need NOT be entered in the Regular Classes at the National Specialty. AKC Champions of Record may be entered in these classes. Dogs and bitches entered in these classes may be altered. You must be ready to produce proof of the AKC performance titles if requested. Performance Titles from venues other than AKC do not qualify. Herding instinct, CGC and Tricks titles do not qualify.

Herding Titled Sweepstakes is open to all Border Collie dogs and bitches nine (9) months of age on the day of the show. Herding Titled Sweeps entries need NOT be entered in the Regular Classes at the National Specialty. AKC Champions of Record may be entered in these classes. At the completion of the individual class judging, each of the class winners shall be brought back into the ring for award of Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes.

All entry money in each class will be divided as follows (rounded to the nearest dollar amount). Any undistributed funds revert to the Club. Thirty-five percent (35%) of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

PUPPY

Classes having 4 or more entries: First – 40%, Second – 30%, Third – 20%, Fourth – 10%.

Classes having 3 entries: First – 50%, Second – 30%, Third – 20%.

Classes having 2 entries: First – 60%, Second – 40%.

Classes having 1 entry: First – 100%.

ALL OTHER SWEEPSATKES

Class winners will win 50% and the remaining placements will be evenly split at 15% of their respective class entry fees.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. Must notify the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who, at the times entries close, have won three first place awards in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class with competition present at a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 60 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the AKC Phone (919) 233-9767. Entry form must be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box at the bottom of the entry form)



The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed/Variety including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

* Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

- Each dog will compete by performing a "Crufts style" heeling course designed by the judge.
- Heeling will be performed off leash and in accordance with the AKC Obedience Regulations
- Elements may include the following:
 - Normal, fast and slow pace
 - Turns at normal or slow pace (including 90 degrees to the right and left, 180 degrees about turn to right and left, diagonal turns to the right and left, circles and arcs),
 - Turns at fast pace (including 90 degrees to the right and left, 180 degrees about turn to right and left, diagonal turns to the right and left, circles and arcs)
 - Multiple and combinations turns at normal and/or slow pace (but not to exceed 360 degrees total)
- Figure eights and/or weaving between cones at normal and/or slow pace
- Stand, Sit and Down from a normal pace: While heeling at normal pace, the dog will be required to be left in each of the following three positions (the order will be the same for each dog) when instructed: stand, sit and down. The handler will give the dog a verbal and/or signal command to take the required position and the handler will continue heeling forward without the dog. The handler will continue without the dog as directed until the handler returns to the dog, at which time the handler, without stopping or pausing, will give the dog a verbal and/or signal command to resume heeling, and the handler and dog will continue forward as instructed.
- A steward will call the pattern
- Maps will be available 30 minutes prior to the start
- Exhibitors will draw for running order at least 30 minutes prior to the start

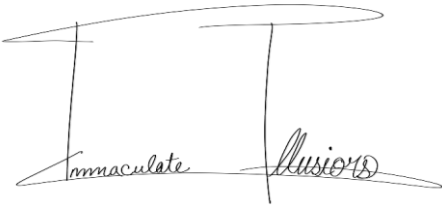

After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are **not acceptable**. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with this agreement. Rule books may be obtained from the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for incorrect or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent which includes entering a dog in a class which the dog is not eligible to compete. **Responsibility for completeness of entry rests solely with entrant.**
3. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. DogZibit will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks.
