Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes at Independent Specialties. The winner of each of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Dual Title Class – The Dual Title Class is open to any AKC Italian Greyhound Breed Champion with at least one AKC prefix title and one AKC suffix title in any combination. (Please refer to the AKC website under titles and abbreviations for further information.) The class will be divided by sex. Altered titled dogs may enter. The winner of this class will NOT compete for Winners or Best of Breed.

Altered Class – The Altered Class is open to any dog or bitch who has been spayed or neutered. The class is divided by sex. Winner of this class will NOT compete for Winners or Best of Breed. All other dog show rules shall apply.

Best Of Breed Competition: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be awarded following Best of Breed.

Judge's Award of Merit: Immediately following the Best of Breed competition, the judge may select, at his/her discretion, up to 10%, but no more than 8, rounded up, of the superior quality specimens entered for Best of Breed Competition at the time of entry closing, disregarding absentees or transfers from the classes. Winners of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch are noneligible for Award of Merit consideration.

Bred-By-Exhibitor Class eligibility: (BBE Class Eligibility) All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC. For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. The Person handling the dog must be the person individually registered with American Kennel Club and are owned or co-owned by any of the breeders as of the date of closing entries for this show. The person handling the dog in the class must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. In any subsequent classes for which dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

Following Best of Breed Judging there will be competition for: Best Puppy in Puppy Classes - Best Bred By Exhibitor from Bred by Classes - Best Veteran from Veteran Classes

Best Puppy Competition: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Regular Puppy Class winners (6-9 mo Puppy Dogs, 6-9 mo Puppy Bitches, 9-12 mo Puppy Dogs, 9-12 mo Puppy Bitches). This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Competition: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Best Bred-by Exhibitor will be selected from the First-Place Winners of the Dog and Bitch Bred-by-Exhibitor classes, both Puppy & Adult. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED. Best Bred-by Exhibitor receives a prize of one free litter registration, donated by AKC.

Best Veteran Competition: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

POINTS AVAILABLE FOR RESERVE

The Italian Greyhound Club of America, Inc. will award a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Italian Greyhound Club of America, Inc. will award a three-point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

Effective immediately, AKC's new Unattended Dogs in Vehicles Policy prohibits leaving dogs unattended in vehicles that are fully enclosed or do not have adequate ventilation and airflow. Simply having fans, air conditioning, temperature monitors, remote alerts, or other electronic devices does not, by themselves, make a vehicle safe for an unattended dog. Owners and handlers are responsible for ensuring dogs are kept in conditions that protect them from heat-related illness, distress, injury, or death.

Violating this policy is considered conduct prejudicial to the best interests of purebred dogs, the sport of purebred dogs, and the American Kennel Club and may result in disciplinary action under the AKC Charter and Bylaws.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES –

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

None of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition.

The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Ch. 11, Sec 8 of the “Rules Applying to Dog Shows” provides that “a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.”

Brace Class (Two dogs, one or more common owner) – Require an entry fee of \$25.00 for the Brace as a UNIT if entered in another class. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time the entry is made. If a dog which is to be part of the Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for “Brace Class Only” with a fee of \$30.00 per unit. In making entries for “Brace Class Only,” full particulars must be given for each dog on individual, regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for “Additional Class” if more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated “Brace No. 1,” “Brace No. 2.”

PLEASE BE RESPONSIBLE

Help keep our show grounds, local motel rooms and areas clean! Exercise dogs in designated areas only and clean up after them! Use outdoor waste cans for disposal of all dog waste. The future of our sport is in your hands. We want to be invited back to our show sites. We thank you in advance for your cooperation!

SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Sweepstakes winners do not go on to further placement in the shows as a result of participating.

PUPPY & JUNIOR SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all Italian Greyhounds 6 months of age and under 24 months of age. All entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class at the Regular entry fee and on the same entry form at this Specialty show. Champions of record are eligible. Dogs may not be shown by anyone who is considered a professional handler (accepting money for showing a dog) unless the dog is co-owned by the professional handler. Indicate your entry in SWEEPSTAKES including age division in the box marked "Additional Classes."

The class winners will compete for Best in Junior Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex in Junior Sweepstakes.

At the completion of the individual class judging, each of the puppy class winners shall be brought back to the ring for awarding of Best Puppy in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Puppy Sweepstakes. The Junior class winners shall then be brought back to the ring for awarding Best Junior in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex Junior Sweepstakes.

The Best in Puppy Sweepstakes and Best in Junior Sweepstakes will compete for overall Best in Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes open to Italian Greyhounds who on the day of the show will be at least 7 years of age. Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in any other class. Champions of record are eligible. Dogs may not be shown by anyone who is considered a professional handler (accepting money for showing a dog) unless the dog is co-owned by the professional handler. **Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes.** Indicate your entry in VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes. Champions of record are eligible.

The class winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes & Best Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes.

SWEEPSTAKES AND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES MONEY PRIZES

All entry money in each class will be divided as follows (rounded to the nearest dollar amount). Any undistributed funds revert to the Club.

Thirty-five percent (35%) of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

Classes having 4 or more entries:	First – 40%, Second – 30%, Third – 20%, Fourth – 10%.
Classes having 3 entries:	First – 50%, Second – 30%, Third – 20%.
Classes having 2 entries:	First – 60%, Second – 40%.
Classes having 1 entry:	First – 100%.

FUTURITY REQUIREMENTS

Dogs must be from a litter which was nominated in a proper and timely fashion. Dogs must have been individually nominated before it reached the age of four (4) months. Dogs shown in Futurity Need NOT be entered in one of the Regular classes in the National Specialty. Indicate your Futurity class with age division in the space provided for on the entry form.

Division of Nomination Fees as Prizes

35% shall be deducted from the total nomination fee purse to be used for Futurity expenses. This will be known as the Futurity General Expense Fund. This Fund shall be used to cover all expenses incurred by the Futurity Stake, i.e., judges, printing, mailing, etc. Since the administrative and judging expense will vary from year to year, an excess in any given year shall be carried over for use in future years. The remaining 65% will be awarded as follows:

60% Best in Futurity
50% Breeder of Record
30% Owner of Record
20% Stud Owner of Record
40% Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity
50% Breeder of Record
30% Owner of Record
20% Stud Owner of Record

Division of Entry Money as Prizes

35% shall be deducted from the total entry fee purse to be used for Futurity expenses, and will be held in the Futurity General Expense fund. The remaining 65% will be awarded as follows:

1 Entry	40%–1st
2 Entries	40%–1st, 30%–2nd
3 Entries	40%–1st, 30%–2nd, 20%–3rd
4 Entries	40%–1st, 30%–2nd, 20%–3rd, 10%–4th

(If less than four competitors, the balance will be divided equally among other placements.)

Fees from each class will be divided among placements in that class. All placements will be divided as such:

60% to Breeder of Record, 40% to Owner of Record.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP – NATIONAL ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.



- Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book and in the show catalog.
- Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Determining Best of Breed/Variety

Breed judging for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members of and current assistants to a professional handler, and any exhibitor that did not indicate on their entry that they were eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Owner-Handled Best of Breed. A dog being "cut" or otherwise "defeated" in the Best of Breed ring remains eligible to compete in the AKC National Owner Handled Series. The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible exhibits based on the program procedures.

If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, Owner-Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

One combined class will be offered for dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months. There will be a selection of Best of Breed 4 & Under 6 Months puppy, and Best of Opposite Sex. An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for all entries. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Puppies are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person or dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy to show dentition for the judge to avoid transmission of illness. Breed standard disqualifications for dentition, and AKC disqualifications for descended testicles shall not be a consideration in this competition.

- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

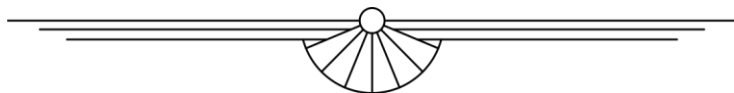

Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are **not acceptable**. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with this agreement. Rule books may be obtained from the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for incorrect or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent which includes entering a dog in a class which the dog is not eligible to compete. **Responsibility for completeness of entry rests solely with entrant.**
3. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. DogZibit will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee.
