Continue through Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel following signs for I-64 E. Continue 14.6 miles. Take exit 286B to merge onto Indian River Rd. Continue on Indian River Rd. for 0.4 miles. Founders Inn and Spa is on the right.

From the South: Take I-95 N. from the North Carolina State Line. Travel about 12 miles to exit 11A to merge onto US-58 E. toward Norfolk. Continue 68.4 miles. 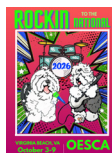

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Classes at a Specialty that does not offer classes beyond Best of Breed.

NR1.10000. Herding Titled (National Only) - This class is to honor those dogs and bitches who have distinguished themselves in the job for which they were bred. Dog & Bitches are eligible to compete if they have one or more AKC herding titles. Herding Instinct Certificates meet the eligibility requirements of this class in this inaugural year. Herding Titled Classes dog/bitches are not required to be Champions of Record.

Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are eligible to compete in single-entry, non-regular classes. Winners of this class will advance to compete in Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other single-entry class.

NR1.39125. Shaved Coat (All Regionals & the National) - Shaved Coat Class for Old English Sheepdog AKC Titled Dogs (Regional & National) Rules:

1. Dog must have an AKC title
2. Class Divided by Sex
3. Dog must have no longer than 2" of regrowth to the coat on any part of the body, head or legs. The judge may excuse any dog from the class that exceeds 2" of coat length.
4. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are eligible for this class.
5. The first place dog and the first place bitch that are undefeated are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

00900. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Only)

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Stud Dog may be entered in the Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. "Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

NR2.09300. Brace Class - A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time the entry is made. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class" if more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2." Please submit brace entries together. Dogs do not have to be entered in another class to be eligible for Brace Class.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

80000. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Event Secretary's Office advised at once. The Event Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK

Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the SAME for each event. Carefully check the block (blocks) for each event in which you wish to enter your dog. You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank, if you are entering your dog in a different class on different events.
